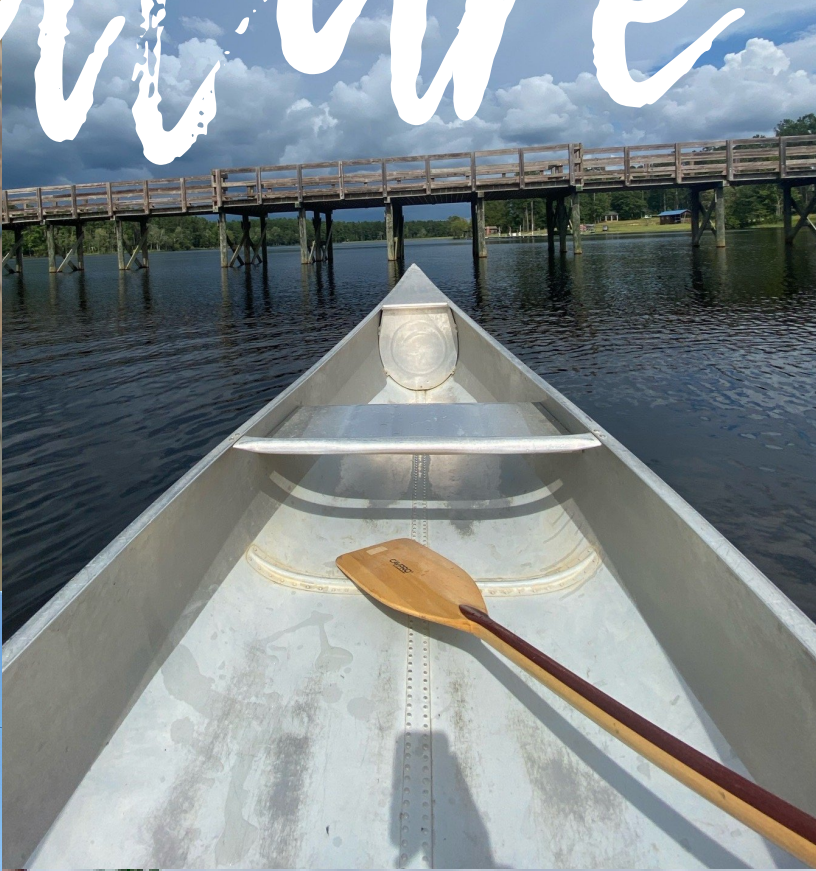

# HIGHLIGHTS

---

## **BASE CAMP**

Black Creek's signature First Year Camper Program focuses on development of leadership skills by teaching the mission of the BSA. This program allows first-time Scouts to work in patrols on Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class requirements.

## **C.O.P.E.**

Black Creek's high and low C.O.P.E. program is a high adventure leadership based program designed to advance personal development and build leadership skills. Our 50 foot climbing wall and 40-foot high ropes course has multiple routes and difficulty levels to keep everyone learning.

## **AQUATICS**

Black Creek is located on the waters of Eagle Lake which spans approximately 40-acres. It is ideal for swimming, kayaking, small boat sailing, paddle-boarding, and canoeing.

## **SHOOTING SPORTS**

Featuring multiple ranges for shotgun, rifle, and archery, Scouts visiting Black Creek can earn merit badges and gain hands-on experience and knowledge on firearm safety. Safety is top priority. Classes are offered at multiple times during the week at multiple ranges to ensure there is an opportunity for everyone to learn. Black Creek also offers Troop shoots.



## **CAMPSITE INFORMATION**

Black Creek offers six tent sites each equipped with twenty large canvas tents on platforms with cots. Each canvas tent sleeps two campers.

Camp sites includes a program/activity shelter with lights, electricity, and fans.

Each program shares a bathroom facility with a neighboring campsite.

Bathrooms are single-use facilities with warm showers and flush toilets.
